Our camp is centrally and conveniently located in the spacious BAIS FAIGA BUILDING AT 350 COURTNEY RD. The building is fully air conditioned. It boasts large classrooms, special activity rooms, an auditorium and large outdoor play areas. We are looking forward to spending another summer in this ideal facility.

To ensure utmost safety and security for our campers, we have once again hired a FULL TIME SECURITY GUARD to be at our premises from Iron Rock Securities.

We are pleased to offer our campers a nutritious SNACK AND LUNCH PROGRAM which consists of a daily lunch menu complete with a fruit/vegetable and a drink. A filling snack is distributed towards the end of the day. This program is included in the camp fee.

Shemesh Day Camp offers optional BUS TRANSPORTATION from Presidential Transportation. To assure the safety of our campers, we have supervising counselors on all our buses. Please see below for details per township.

<u>Lakewood Residents</u>: Due to the expanding of our community to neighboring townships, most of our routes are currently operating out of Lakewood. Although we will try to provide bus transportation to as many areas in Lakewood as we can, you will be contacted If your address is outlying from our Lakewood routes and therefore can only be serviced by our van company (see pricing below).

<u>Jackson Residents</u>: We provide transportation to many areas in Jackson including areas as far as Hampshire Hills, Aldrich Road, and streets off White Rd, East Veterans, and the Brewers Bridge areas. We will be offering transportation to more areas this coming summer 2026. Please inquire from our office.

<u>NEW\*\* Howell:</u> We will be providing transportation to select areas along the Jackson border and behind ShopRite plaza. Please inquire before signing up for transportation.

<u>Manchester Residents</u>: We will provide transportation to the Pine Lake Park and Holly Oak neighborhoods in Manchester.

<u>Toms River Residents</u>: We provide transportation to Tallymawr and Walden Woods neighborhoods. <u>Please inquire regarding other areas before signing up for transportation</u>.

#### DRESS CODE FOR SUMMER 2026:

Shemesh Day Camp prides itself in its commitment to instilling values of Torah in all aspects of our summer program. Through our daily davening stories, our weekly middos shiur and our Erev Shabbos Parsha program, we are confident that the girls will grow in their Yiras Shomayim throughout the summer spent at Shemesh.

Along the same lines, our standards of Tznius and refinement are uncompromised, both in the Bais Yaakov girls that we choose as counselors, and among the campers in our Senior division. Please see below for the dress code we have implemented.

- Girls entering 1st-5th grade must dress in a Tznius fashion. Sleeves must cover the elbows and skirts must cover the knees. Knee socks or tights are required.
- Mothers of all campers (in both Junior and Senior divisions) that are coming
  to camp to drop off/pick up their children must be dressed according to the
  Tznius standards of the Lakewood community, following the Halachos
  stated above.
