Our camp is centrally and conveniently located in the spacious **BAS FAIGA BUILDING AT 350 COURTNEY RD.** The building is fully air conditioned. It boasts large classrooms, special activity rooms, an auditorium and large outdoor play areas. We are looking forward to spending another summer in this ideal facility.

To ensure utmost safety and security for our campers, we have once again hired a **FULL TIME SECURITY GUARD** to be at our premises from Iron Rock Securities.

We are pleased to offer our campers a nutritious **SNACK AND LUNCH PROGRAM** which consists of a daily lunch menu complete with a fruit/vegetable and a drink. A filling snack is distributed towards the end of the day. This program is included in the camp fee.

Shemesh Day Camp offers optional **BUS TRANSPORTATION** to and from camp. To assure the safety of our campers, we will have supervising counselors on all our buses. Please see below for details per township.

Lakewood Residents: We try to provide transportation to all areas in Lakewood. If your child is in an area that is outlying from our bus routes, we will try our best to use alternate venues to offer you transportation. (hired carpool/van service).

Jackson Residents: We provide transportation to many areas in Jackson including areas as far as Hampshire Hills and Brookwood 4 in Northern Jackson and streets off White Rd, Hope Chapel, and the Flair/Brewers Bridge area. Please inquire if you are unsure whether we provide transportation to your area.

Toms River Residents: We provide transportation to Tallymawr, Walden Woods and stops along Whitesville Rd. Please inquire regarding other areas before signing up for transportation.

NEW Manchester Residents: We will provide transportation to the Pine Lake Park and Holly Oak neighborhoods in Manchester.

Howell/Brick: At this time, we do not provide transportation to these areas. Some neighborhoods in Howell may be included in our Jackson route. Please inquire before signing up for transportation.

DRESS CODE FOR SENIOR DIVISION 2023:

Shemesh Day Camp prides itself in its commitment to instilling values of Torah in all aspects of our summer program. Through our daily davening stories, our weekly middos shiur and our Erev Shabbos Parsha program, we are confident that the girls will grow in their Yiras Shomayim throughout the summer spent at Shemesh.

Along the same lines, our standards of Tznius and refinement are uncompromised, both in the Bais Yaakov girls that we choose as counselors, and among the campers in our Senior division. Please see below for the dress code we have implemented.

- Girls ages 6 and up must dress in a Tznius fashion. Sleeves must cover the elbows and skirts must cover the knees for all Senior campers. Knee socks or tights are required.
- Mothers of all campers (in both Junior and Senior divisions) that are coming to camp to drop off/pick up their children must be dressed according to the Tznius standards of the Lakewood community, following the Halachos stated above.
